UNBRIDLED FRILL set the pace under pressure, shook clear on the turn, extended the lead in upper stretch and proved much the best under steady urging. BROADWAY ALI broke out a bit at the start, pressed the pace on the outside, chased the winner while off the rail on the turn and earned the place. CALIROSE was urged along while off the pace, raced three then two wide on the turn, came under a drive in upper stretch and lacked the needed response while able to get the show. JUDYS CURE brushed with a rival at the start, was urged along on the outside, raced four wide on the turn and also lacked the needed response. SWEET LINDSAY settled while under some urging, dropped to the inside on the turn, drifted in a tad passing the chute and failed to rally. CUVANDO dropped back while ridden along, saved ground on the turn and failed to respond. LOOSE PLAY brushed with a rival at the start, was urged along on the outside, raced three wide on the turn, moved out in upper stretch and also failed to rally. FAST ACTING CAT bobbled at the start, chased the pace, raced three wide on the turn and tired.
