**Footnotes**

KING CORAL pressed the pace on the outside of three rivals, chased four wide on the turn, rallied into the final furlong, closed well to get the lead near the sixteenth-pole then edged clear under steady urging. PORT TAPIT dueled between rivals, led into the final furlong, lost the lead near the sixteenth-pole and was outfinished while able to hold the place. WENCESLAO (MEX) was ridden along while off the pace, raced four wide on the turn, rallied in the final furlong and closed well to get the show. SEA MASTER raced just off the pace while under some restraint, was urged some while off the rail on the turn, drafted behind the leaders leaving the turn, was asked for his best in upper stretch and lacked the needed response. KIP'S MESCALERO was carried in at the start, rushed up on the inside, dueled through the turn, battled into the final furlong and gave way. UNBRIDLED VENTURE dueled between rivals, vied three wide on the turn and tired. EASTON JACK was in a bit tight at the start, raced towards the back while ridden along and failed to threaten. SARAH'S CHIEF broke out at the start, was ridden along while off the pace, dropped back while inside on the turn, came out and bumped hard with COCKED AND LOCKED near the quarter-pole and failed to respond. RICH MONARCHOS drifted out in the early going, raced well back in the field, went three wide on the turn and was no factor. COCKED AND LOCKED bumped with a rival at the start, chased the pace, raced four then three wide on the turn, was bumped hard by SARAH'S CHIEF near the quarter-pole and faded. MAE'S RACER came in at the start, was hard ridden towards the inside, dropped back leaving the backstretch and retreated. PROSPECTOR'S TURN broke in and bumped with a rival, raced at the rear of the field, saved ground on the turn and was outrun.
