TOOK OUT was reserved near mid field, rallied on the final turn, swung five wide entering the stretch, engaged UNRAVEL near the furlong marker, and proved best late under moderate urging. UNRAVEL was well placed on the inside, moved off the rail with a half mile to run, closed the gap on the final turn, rallied four wide entering the stretch, gained the lead near the three-sixteenth pole, was challenged by TOOK OUT passing the furlong marker, and was outfinished. CRAFTY TAYLOR set the clear pace, was collared at the top of the stretch, and tired. GENTLE ROAR tracked the pace, dropped back on the final turn, and failed to rally. IGLO ALPIR settled while saving ground, raced in the middle of the pack, and went evenly throughout. MERCI was off a touch slow, raced towards the rear, and failed to reach contention. MRS. CORLEY was off slowly, raced four wide on both turns, and showed little. CHRISTO FLYAWAY dropped to the rear of the field, and was always outrun. KATJA CAT was off a bit slowly, raced four wide on the first turn, and was through early.
