**Footnotes**

MISTY VISIONS contested the pace with SERENA VENUS, vied inside on the turn, battled gamely in the stretch, drifted out a bit late and prevailed under steady handling. SERENA VENUS contested the pace on the outside, vied three wide on the turn, dueled with the winner in the stretch and missed while clear for the place. FATE'S TREASURE broke outward at the start, was ridden along on the outside, raced four then three wide on the turn and lacked the needed response while best of the rest. RIVERSIDE PARADE was ridden along while off the pace, raced three then two wide on the turn and came up empty. DOVE FEATHER raced well back in the field, went three wide on the turn, swung five wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. IF DIRTWEREDOLLAR was fractious in the gate, broke outward and bumped with a rival then dropped back, raced near the rear of the field while on the inside, moved off the rail midway through the turn, came four wide into the stretch and was no factor. SWEET LITTLE CAT settled off the pace, saved ground on the turn, steadied off heels passing the quarter-pole, moved three wide into the stretch and faltered then was not urged late. FIRST SERVE came in at the start and bumped with a rival, was well placed behind the leaders, raced off the rail on the turn, dropped in near the quarter-pole and faded. PEACEINTHESPIRIT broke inward and was off a bit slow, raced near the back while ridden along, propped a bit near the seven-sixteenths pole, dropped to the rail on the turn and faltered.
