MECKENIZED dueled on the inside, kicked clear in upper stretch, and drew off to prove much the best. SECRET WEDGE dueled on the outside, vied into upper stretch, and proved no match for the winner while clear for second. HIGH CASCADE pressed the pace three wide, failed to match the top two, and weakened while able to hold the show. SYBLE SEATTLE was ridden along from the start, raced well back in the field, and saved ground to no avail. IT'S A BOY chased the pace four wide, vied into stretch, and faded. LINCOLN CENTER dropped to the rear after the start, raced well back into the stretch, and failed to threaten. ZIGGY'S HAYLO was always outrun.
