Footnotes

SOME QUICK broke inward and bumped with a rival, tracked the pace on the outside, took the lead near the three-eighths pole, dueled with INLINEFORPICTURES on the far turn, disposed of that rival in upper stretch and drew away under a strong drive. ALBERT W. bumped with a rival at the start, raced five wide on the first turn, settled near the middle of the field, rallied four wide into the stretch and finished willingly for the place. JUDYS FAVORITE SON raced three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, was urged along while three then four wide on the far turn and got up for the show. INLINEFORPICTURES set the clear pace, was challenged near the seven-sixteenths pole, dueled with the winner on the far turn, lost touch with that rival in upper stretch and tired then was caught for the show. WINNING FORUM was caught five wide into the first turn then shifted in, settled towards the rear of the field, was roused on the far turn, shifted out at the top of the stretch, came between rivals outside the furlong marker and improved position. WINGS INCLUDED broke outward and bumped with a rival, raced four wide on the first turn, lingered towards the rear of the field, was urged along while four then five wide on the far turn and failed to threaten. PARTY LIGHTS bumped with a rival at the start, settled on the inside, saved ground into the stretch and came up empty. BEHRING raced three wide on the first turn, was urged along towards the front of the field, chased the leaders on the far turn and gave

way. HOLDINGOUTFORAHERO was off slow, lagged at the rear of the field, was roused near the seven-sixteenths pole, shifted four wide near the quarter-pole and never reached contention. SEEKING THE WILD raced four wide on the first turn, was forwardly placed on the outside, chased three wide on the far turn and faded. AMERICAN PATTERN was bumped on both sides at the start, settled near the middle of the field, saved ground on the far turn and failed to respond. BUBBA JR. was unprepared at the start, steadied while rank early, raced well back in the field and showed little. (Rail at 0 Feet)
