BULLFIGHT broke outward and brushed with a rival, set the pace while off the rail, shook clear in upper stretch and held well under strong urging. SNOOKY'S IMAGE was hard ridden on the outside, chased four wide on the turn and was second best. WILBY'S RAY pressed the pace on the outside, vied three wide on the turn and weakened while able to hold the show. JUKEBOX JUNKIE brushed with a rival at the start, was in tight between rivals near the seven-sixteenths pole, chased off the rail on the turn and came up empty. SLEETWORTH was urged along towards the rear of the field, raced three to four wide on the turn and failed to rally. EAGLE TWO HUNDRED was hustled from the start then ridden along on the inside, was shuffled back near the three-eighths pole, saved ground on the turn and lacked the needed response. BELIEV'NS ACHIEV'N pressed then chased the pace, was in tight while dropping back near the furlong marker then gave way. ROYAL DEVIL broke a bit slow, raced well back in the field and was no factor. SUNDAY SAMURAI was void of speed, dropped well behind the field, saved ground on the turn and trailed. (Rail at 0 Feet)
