Footnotes

K J'S BEAUX was bumped hard on both sides at the start, pressed the pace on the outside, dueled with PARANORMAL on the turn, edged clear in upper stretch and held well under strong urging. SYN RIVER broke outward and jostled with a rival then was taken up a bit, was ridden along towards the rear, raced three then four wide on the turn, moved to five wide near the quarter-pole and finished willingly for the place. WHIZVILLE chased the pace, raced three to four wide on the turn and lacked the needed kick while able to secure the show. SPEED STREET broke in a bit, angled in midway down the backstretch, moved out on the turn, came three wide into the stretch and improved position. CATAPULT SHOT raced well back in the field, went three then four wide on the turn, drifted out in mid-stretch, jostled with STOCKBROKER late and also improved position. SILENT ALERT was urged along while off the pace, raced three to four wide on the turn and came up empty. RED RUSH raced towards the rear of the field, steadied near the sixteenth-pole and was no factor. STOCKBROKER bumped hard with a rival at the start, saved ground near the back of the field, moved out in upper stretch, jostled with CATAPULT SHOT late and never reached contention. JAYNES IRISH OPEN broke outward at the start, chased the pace through the turn and tired. PARANORMAL broke out and bumped hard with a rival, set the pace under pressure, dueled inside on the turn and gave way. TUCKERS BUDDY was bumped hard on both sides at the start, was ridden along on the inside, saved ground on the turn and dropped out. DUCKNDODGIN bumped with a rival at the start, chased

the pace through the turn and faded. TEXAS LIGHT bumped with a rival at the start, was through early and retreated.
