SPECIAL U F O quickly moved clear, raced off the rail early on the first turn then dropped to the inside, set the pace through moderate fractions, turned away GREYBILL leaving the far turn, responded well when set down in upper stretch and proved best under steady urging. BREATHETHEFIRE went four wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, was ridden along while off the rail on the far turn, came three wide into the stretch and finished with good energy to get the place. PALM ROAD broke a bit slow, lagged at the rear of the field, was ridden along while off the rail early on the far turn, shifted four wide near the quarter-pole and finished willingly for the show. GREYBILL tracked the leader, chased two then three wide on the far turn and tired. TATER RED settled on the inside, was asked near the quarter-pole, came off the rail at the top of the stretch and failed to rally. TARMAC moved up in hand early on the backstretch, was reserved off the pace, saved ground while under urging on the far turn and also failed to rally. RUNAHOLEINTHEWIND went three wide on the first turn, settled in the middle of the field, was ridden along while three wide on the far turn and stopped. STREET LIFE BLUES broke about three lengths slow, went five wide on the first turn, settled off the pace on the outside, raced four wide on the far turn and faltered.
