PRINCE OF THE ROXY was bumped at the start and forced in but recovered quickly, disputed the pace, dueled inside on the turn, battled with the runner-up into the final furlong, disposed of that rival under the whip then was hand ridden in the final sixteenth while best. FUN JET broke in and bumped with a rival, disputed the pace on the outside, vied three then two wide on the turn, battled into the final furlong and was outfinished while clearly second best. BLACKWELL FIVE broke a bit slow, moved up then chased the pace, went two to three wide on the turn, pursued the top two into the final furlong and weakened while able to get the show. ALEDO BLING lugged in early, dropped back while hard ridden and racing greenly, went four then three wide on the turn and failed to rally. DARYLSLITTLEENGINE was very fractious in the gate, broke a bit slow, moved up then chased the pace, raced near the inside on the turn, pursued the top two into the final furlong and tired. MAC WITT was hard ridden towards the back, went five then four wide on the turn, drifted out in upper stretch and failed to threaten. SLEWIE'S BLING broke a bit slow then was forced in sharply, raced at the rear of the field, saved ground early on the turn, shifted three wide near the five-sixteenths pole, moved to five wide late on the bend, drifted in near the furlong marker and was no factor. WITT'S FLAME was fractious in the gate, broke a bit slow, was ridden along on the outside, dropped in near the seven-sixteenths pole, raced off the rail on the turn and failed to respond.
