MUCHO MELLON was urged along on the outside, chased five wide on the turn, pursued the leading duo into the final furlong, gained the lead nearing the sixteenth-pole and edged clear under good handling. SHELLAC disputed the pace on the inside of two rivals, dueled with an opponent in upper stretch, jumped tracks near the sixteenth-pole and was outfinished while able to get the place. CATSWAGGIN disputed the pace between rivals, dueled with SHELLAC in upper stretch, battled into the final sixteenth and weakened while just able to hold the show. KELSI'S ART chased the pace, raced four wide on the turn, steadied at the top of the stretch, moved to the outside and finished willingly to just miss the show. MALIBU DOUBLE was urged along towards the rear, saved ground early on the turn then came off the rail, raced under a vigorous drive in upper stretch, moved out near the sixteenth-pole and also finished willingly to just miss the show. ONE MORE TANGO disputed the pace on the outside, vied three wide on the turn and tired. GO LODED was urged along at the back, raced towards the inside on the turn and failed to threaten. AMOROUS INTENT moved up to race just off the pace, dropped back early on the turn, lugged out five wide near the five-sixteenths pole, continued five wide into the stretch, drifted in outside the furlong marker and stopped.
