Footnotes

PACIFIC TSUNAMI pressed the pace on the outside, vied four then three wide on the turn, gained the lead in upper stretch and gamely prevailed under strong urging. BOOM BOOM BUBBA was urged along while off the pace, raced near the rail on the turn, rallied into the final furlong and closed strongly but just missed. EAGLE TWO HUNDRED was away alertly, showed good speed between rivals then chased the pace, moved in near the seven-sixteenths pole, saved ground on the turn, swung out in upper stretch and closed gradually but missed. ORPHAN BRIGADE was sent hard from the start, lugged out while setting the pace, vied off the rail on the turn, lost the lead in upper stretch and gave way. INDY RECORD was ridden along at the back, dropped to the rail on the turn and lacked the needed response. THUNDERPANTS was ridden along while off the pace, raced three then four wide on the turn and also failed to rally. K D KING bumped with a rival at the start, pressed between rivals, was in tight while three wide on the turn and came up empty. (Rail at 0 Feet)
