**Footnotes**

TIMELESS DREAMER was well placed on the inside, shifted outside of TEE PEE TOMAHAWK at the top of the stretch, closed well to gain the lead outside the sixteenth marker, then edged clear under steady right hand pressure. TEE PEE TOMAHAWK pressed the pace on the inside, took the lead passing the five-sixteenths marker, inched away in upper stretch, was collared outside the sixteenth pole, and proved no match for the winner late. NOTABLY MYSTIC settled off the pace while saving ground, was in tight leaving the turn, angled out inside the furlong marker, and lacked the needed rally while securing the show. BIRDIE BARRAGE chased the pace while three wide, came four wide into the stretch, and gave way. SUCCESSFUL CAT was completely void of speed, raced off the rail on the turn, and failed to threaten. SING TO THE MOON was away alertly at the start, set the pace under heavy pressure, lost the lead passing the five-sixteenths marker, and faded. RAMMERS BEST was ridden along on the outside, lugged out a bit while five wide on the turn, and faltered. JADE DANCER was void of speed, saved ground on the turn, and showed little. RACEY CASEY raced well back in the field, lugged out to be six or seven wide on the turn, and never reached contention.
