Footnotes

BONJURNOSE chased the pace on the outside then three wide on the turn, dropped to the rail passing the quarter-pole, moved out near the furlong marker and closed fast to win going away. CHANAN was hustled to the lead, set the pace, moved clear leaving the backstretch, dictated terms through the turn, was collared near the sixteenth-pole and proved no match for the winner while able to get the place. DOWN HOME BOY was ridden along while off the pace, raced three wide early on the turn then dropped to one off the rail and lacked the needed response while up for the show. CAMERONLUCKYPRIDE leaned out at the start and hit the gate, was ridden along while off the pace, raced four then three wide on the turn, dropped in entering the stretch and failed

to rally. GLASS MACHINE jostled with a rival at the start, was ridden along while off the pace, saved ground on the turn and also lacked the needed response. INLINEFORPICTURES jostled with a rival at the start, pressed the pace on the inside, dropped back then moved out leaving the backstretch, chased the leader on the turn and tired. LUCADO was ridden along while off the pace, steadied near the half-mile pole, steadied again outside the five-sixteenths pole and failed to threaten. DE ICE CAT lacked early speed, raced four to five wide on the turn and was no factor. KRISTYS BOONESMILL broke a bit awkwardly, raced four wide on the turn and failed to respond. TATES MANDATE was in tight early then dropped to the rear, raced three to four on the turn, moved to five wide near the quarter-pole and never reached contention. PROSPECTORSCRUSADE was in tight near the half-mile pole, saved ground on the turn and also failed to respond. (Rail at 10 Feet)
