DOCTOR BRASCH raced three wide on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, chased three wide on the far turn, made a bid entering the stretch, battled with rivals into the final furlong then edged clear under steady urging. B'WANAGOLDMINE was unhurried on the inside, saved ground into the stretch and finished well but was second best. GRETSKY raced three then two wide on the first turn, prompted the pace, vied off the rail on the far turn, battled into the final furlong and weakened while able to get the show. QUE DESEO was in tight late on the first turn then rated off the pace, raced between rivals on the far turn and lacked the needed kick. RARE FLYER was in a bit tight late on the first turn, settled on the outside, raced three to four wide on the far turn and also lacked the needed kick. WINCHESTER BAY dropped to the rail late on the first turn, set the pace through solid fractions, vied inside on the far turn and gave way. GREEN DIGGER was a bit rank early then well placed on the inside, saved ground into the stretch and came up empty. ROYAL STEPPER saved ground on the first turn, lagged at the rear of the field, raced off the rail on the first turn and showed little. (Rail at 0 Feet)
