Footnotes

HOLY SAINT tracked the pace on the outside, made a bid leaving the backstretch, vied four then three wide on the turn, inched clear coming to the three-sixteenths pole, extended the advantage in upper stretch and held well under strong urging. BENDANIE settled on the outside, advanced near the half-mile pole, made a bid leaving the backstretch, vied five then four wide on the turn, lost touch with the winner in upper stretch, fought on willingly in the final furlong and was clearly second best. WHY BILL WHY was rated off the early pace then came under some urging, raced three then four wide on the turn and lacked the needed response while just able to get the show. RAIN LIKE NO OTHER stumbled at the start, moved up to contest the pace, dropped back leaving the backstretch, chased two then three wide on the turn and tired. SIR JAIME pressed the pace on the inside, dropped back near the three-eighths pole, chased while off the rail on the turn and weakened. MATAMBRE contested the pace, vied two to three wide on the turn and capitulated. FIN DOCTORE was reserved early then came under some urging, went three wide on the turn and came up empty. ROMP IN HOME settled at the rear of the field, saved ground while urged along on the turn and failed to threaten. BIG TONY settled on the inside, moved up under some urging near the half-mile pole, was urged along while inside on the turn and also came up empty.
