Footnotes

TWO JAYS SECRET jostled with a rival after the start, stalked the leaders while under a snug hold, rallied into the final furlong and closed well to get up late. BARNETT SHALE raced three wide on the first turn, dropped to one off the rail near the three-quarter pole, contested the pace between horses, vied just off the rail on the far turn, inched clear in upper stretch, shortened stride late and was caught. HONOR MR PECK broke outward then was hustled, raced four wide on the first turn, contested the pace on the outside, vied outside on the far turn, came three wide into the stretch, drifted out near the furlong marker and was outfinished while well clear for the show. SPECIAL ELECTION raced three to four wide on the first turn, lagged near the back of the field, raced three wide on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch and improved position. CONGO BAY settled off the pace, was roused on the far turn and failed to respond. SUSHI JOE bumped with a rival at the start then was taken up, was rank while reserved early, came under a ride on the far turn and also failed to respond. CLASSIC COWBOY jostled with a rival after the start, contested the pace on the inside of rivals, came up empty on the far turn and faded. LITTLE SCOUT was through early and retreated while near the rail.
