Footnotes

BATESVILLE broke outward and bumped with a rival, chased the pace, raced two to three wide on the turn, swung five wide into the stretch, rallied into the final furlong and closed strongly to win going away. OFFLEE TUFF broke outward and bumped with a rival, duelled between horses, vied three wide on the turn, battled determinedly in the stretch but was outfinished late while able to get the place. WHERE'S MY WIRE was forced out at the start, raced near the inside while urged along, saved ground on the turn, rallied inside in upper stretch and closed well but missed the place. GRAND CASA bumped with a rival at the start, duelled on the inside, inched clear in upper stretch, held the lead into the final furlong but weakened and was overtaken. PHILLED UP duelled between rivals, dropped back a bit while off the rail on the turn and lacked the needed kick. GOING SOUTH was ridden along while off the pace, raced three to four wide on the turn, came six wide into the stretch and finished willingly. SPEED MONSTER was bumped on both sides at the start, duelled on the outside the four wide on the turn and gave way. BLUE RACER was ridden along towards the rear, raced four to five wide on the turn, came six wide into the stretch and failed to rally. KELEVRA bumped with a rival after the start, raced three wide on the turn and failed to threaten. CRUSADER'S CHOICE bumped with a rival at the start, raced three wide on the turn and was no factor. CAT GONE WILD was ridden along on the outside, raced four to five wide on the

turn and came up empty. TM'S YESWECAN broke outward and bumped with a rival, saved ground near the back and was outrun. (Rail at 0 Feet)
