ROYAL VALID was urged along while off the pace, raced three wide on the turn, came four wide into the stretch, rallied on the outside of BRAXTON COUNTY, closed strongly with that rival and narrowly prevailed under strong urging. BRAXTON COUNTY chased the pace, raced near the inside on the turn, came three wide into the stretch, rallied on the inside of ROYAL VALID, closed strongly alongside that rival and just missed. WE ADORE THEODORE broke out and bumped with a rival, chased the dueling leaders, engaged those rivals while three wide on the turn, dueled into the final sixteenth then was outfinished while able to get the place. GRAND CASA dueled on the inside of JOHN LOUIS CLASSIC, vied inside on the turn, battled into the final furlong and tired. SHADOW'S BABY was ridden along towards the rear, raced four wide on the turn, dropped to three wide into the stretch and improved position. JOHN LOUIS CLASSIC dueled on the outside, vied between rivals on the turn and gave way. AGGIE APPEAL chased the pace, dropped back near the three-eighths pole, raced two then three wide on the turn and came up empty. SWIFT FLYER ducked in after the start, moved up while urged along, steadied near the three-eighths pole, saved ground into the stretch and failed to rally in a tough trip. BAILANDO bumped with a rival at the start, was urged along while just off the pace, raced two then three wide on the turn, moved four wide near the quarter-pole and capitulated. INHOPEWEARESAVED was urged along while just off the pace, raced three then four wide on the turn, moved to five wide near the quarter-pole and had nothing left. BADGE OF KROLL was reluctant to load then bumped on both sides at the start, ducked out shortly thereafter, raced at the rear of the field, went three wide on the turn and was no factor. MILES ABLAZE was off three or four lengths slow, raced three to four wide on the turn and never reached contention. (Rail at 0 Feet)
