TEXAS BREWED prompted the pace on the outside, took the lead leaving the far turn, kicked clear in upper stretch and held well under strong urging. STATICE was taken back before the first turn then angled in, raced between rivals while under a snug hold, waited in traffic on the far turn, was roused passing the quarter-pole and finished willingly but failed to threaten his stablemate. MR BROCK was hustled to the lead, set the pace through moderate fractions, lost the lead at the top of the stretch and weakened while able to hold the show. TRUE EMOTION raced four wide on the first turn, settled just off the pace, chased four wide on the far turn and came up empty. FORMAL TONE raced three wide on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, chased three wide on the far turn and also came up empty. GABRIEL'S MISSION was rated on the inside, chased the leaders on the far turn, was in tight inside the quarter-pole and gave way. C H LEUTWIL raced six then five wide on the first turn, moved up on the outside, chased five wide on the far turn and faded. WASABI raced five wide early on the first turn then dropped to three wide, lagged at the rear of the field and failed to threaten.
