KISS MY ABBIE was ridden along while off the pace, raced off the rail on the turn, gained ground in upper stretch, moved out near the furlong marker, closed well to get the lead passing the sixteenth-pole then moved clear under good handling. NEV'S LEGEND was ridden along towards the rear, raced four wide on the turn and finished willingly for the place. SPECIAL U F O contested the pace, vied near the inside on the turn, battled into the final sixteenth and weakened while clear for the show. FORGOT TO FILE contested the pace on the outside, vied three wide on the turn, battled into the final sixteenth and tired. COOL HAND MIKE chased the pace on the outside, raced three to four wide on the turn and capitulated. ONCE A NIGHT was ridden along towards the back, raced off the rail on the turn and failed to threaten. HE HAS BLING broke three to four lengths behind the field then ducked in, raced at the back while on the inside, saved ground on the turn and was no factor. SAM THE SPACER was ridden along while off the pace, saved ground on the turn and failed to respond.
