Footnotes

GATHERING SKY was well placed on the inside, saved ground on the turn, rallied along the rail in upper stretch, closed well to get the lead near the sixteenth-pole and prevailed under right hand urging. LUCKY CRITTER lacked early speed, raced three wide on the turn, swung out at the top of the stretch and finished fast but was too late. ENCHANTED MELODY showed good speed, dueled on the inside, inched clear briefly outside the eighth-pole, lost the lead near the sixteenth-pole and was outfinished while drifting out slightly late. SHAMROCK PLACE was away alertly, dueled between horses, chased three wide on the turn and was also outfinished. COME HEAR was ridden along towards the rear of the field, saved ground on the turn and lacked the needed kick. BUBBIE'S LOVE bumped twice with PLUSH TREASURE early, steadied off heels near the seven-sixteenths pole, raced in tight quarters on the turn and lacked the needed response. PLUSH TREASURE bumped twice with BUBBIE'S LOVE early, shifted out near the seven-sixteenths pole, raced three wide on the turn and came up empty. WILD MOMIE was hustled from the start, dueled between rivals then on the outside and tired. FINE COORDINATOR broke a length slow, saved ground near the back of the field and failed to rally. MARE POWER settled on the outside, shifted in leaving the backstretch, raced off the rail on the turn, was roused in upper stretch, steadied repeatedly while blocked in the final furlong and lost all chance. TAKEN PLACE was bumped in the hindquarters at the start, showed good speed, chased three to four wide on the turn and gave way. PANDA BEARS DANCER was fractious behind the gate, broke inward and bumped TAKEN PLACE, raced well back in the field and never reached contention. (Rail at 10 Feet)
