Footnotes

NO RISK NO GAIN was beaten for speed, moved closer on the turn, shifted five wide into the stretch, closed well to get the lead passing the furlong marker and proved best under strong handling. DREAM OF ANGELS bobbed slightly at the start then bumped with a rival, was ridden along on the outside, chased four wide on the turn, made a bid at the top of the stretch, battled with NO RISK NO GAIN in the final furlong and was outfinished. FIRE WHEEL was a bit reluctant to load, pressed the pace between rivals, drew even near the quarter-pole, vied into the final furlong and weakened. AXEL PEGASUS was hard ridden behind the leading group, moved in to save ground on the turn, held a good striking position into upper stretch but lacked the needed response. FLAGPOLE HILL bumped with a rival just after the start, chased the pace on the outside, vied three wide on the turn and tired. LUMBERJACK CAT lacked early speed, remained well back into the stretch and showed little. PROUD LEADER set the pace under pressure, battled into the final furlong then gave way. DEZ ducked in badly at the start, raced well back in the field and never reached contention. SWEET IMMERSION showed no speed and was always outrun.
