No nomination fee. \$250 to pass the entry box and an additional \$250 to start with \$50,000 guaranteed of which \$30,000 to the owner of the winner, \$10,000 to second, \$5,500 to third, \$3,000 to fourth and \$1,500 to fifth. Weights: Three Years Old, 117 lbs., Older, 123 lbs. Non-winners of \$30,000 on the turf in 2007 allowed 3 lbs.; \$20,000 in 2007, 5 lbs.; \$18,000 in 2006-2007, 7 lbs. Maiden and claiming races not considered in allowances. Startersto be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. High weights preferred (on the scale). Total earnings in 2006-2007 will be used in determining the order of preference of horses assigned equal weights. The field will be limited to twelvve starters. Horses not drawing a starting position in the gate will receive a refund of the entry fee. A suitable award will be presented to the winning owner. Nominations closed Thursday, June 14, 2007 with 30 nominations. (If Deemed inadvisable by management to run this race over the Turf course, it will be run on the main track at Five Furlongs.) INDIAN BREEZE chased the dueling leaders, raced three wide on the turn, battled determinedly in the stretch and prevailed under strong urging. SENECA SONG dueled on the outside, battled gamely in the stretch but was denied. MOST BEAUTIFUL drifted in outside the half-mile pole and bothered rivals, was urged along on the outside, raced four wide on the turn, drifted out while making a bid near the furlong marker and was outfinished while able to get the show. TEMPTING DATE broke a bit slow then was taken up, was forced in then steadied outside the half-mile pole, moved closer on the turn, waited behind rivals inside the quarter-pole, shifted inward in upper stretch, bumped with HERES A MEMORY and lacked room passing the furlong marker then finished willingly in a brutal trip. HERES A MEMORY dueled on the inside, bumped with TEMPTING DATE passing the furlong marker and tired. YO FANCI broke a bit slow, was forced in then steadied outside the half-mile pole, raced off the rail on the turn, steadied slightly inside the quarter-pole, shifted five wide into the stretch and failed to rally. CAPE SUNSET broke a bit slow, raced well back in the field while near the rail and failed to threaten. ANNIE SAVOY broke a bit slow, clipped heels outside the half-mile pole, dropped well behind the field and was no factor. (Rail at 10 Feet)
