SUNNY STEIN broke alertly from the outside post, quickly sped clear, crossed over to the inside, was challenged near the half-mile pole, shook clear midway through the turn, extended the advantage in upper stretch and held under strong urging. BRINKS BABY chased the pace, dropped to the inside early on the turn, saved ground into the stretch, pursued the winner into the final furlong, moved out near the sixteenth-pole and finished willingly for the place. SISTER SIX was ridden along while off the pace, raced four wide on the turn and finished with good energy to garner the show. P K'S PHILLY was urged along while just off the pace, chased three wide on the turn and tired. PRIVATE NATIVE was urged along towards the rear, saved ground on the turn and failed to rally. BLUES IN THE GRASS was ridden along while off the pace, raced off the rail on the turn and failed to respond. GLOREE DEE raced well back in the field, went three wide on the turn and was no factor. MSDIAMONDCITY chased the pace, drew even near the half-mile pole, dropped back midway through the turn and came up empty.
