Footnotes

FORT BRAGG was away alertly, sprinted clear to dictate terms, responded well when set down at the top of the stretch and drew off under a vigorous hand ride. ROCKET JUNIOR was urged along while off the pace, raced three wide on the turn and secured the place while no match for the winner. GUN TOWN was ridden along in the second flight, raced between rivals through the turn and weakened while just able to get the show. ROYAL MAMBO was ridden along on the outside of a rival, raced off the rail on the turn, angled out sharply inside the furlong marker and failed to rally. ONE SPECIAL JUDGE was ridden along on the inside, saved ground on the turn and failed to threaten. LOBO JOE was ridden along in the second flight, raced three to four wide on the turn and came up empty. SUDDEN SIDE leaned out at the start, lacked speed while ridden along, raced three wide on the turn and was no factor. MIDNIGHT EXPLOSION chased the solo leader through the turn and tired. VALID ECHO was urged along on the outside, raced four wide on the turn and faltered.
