REFUSED TO COMMIT raced inside on the first turn, settled off the pace, advanced leaving the backstretch, moved up while three wide on the far turn, made a bid passing the quarter-pole, edged clear outside the furlong marker and drew away while kept to the task. IRISH SOUL raced two to three wide on the first turn, made a strong middle move, chased four wide on the far turn and secured the place while no match for the winner. CARCAVA'S HUNT was well rated while setting the pace on the inside, came under urging on the far turn, lost the lead at the top of the stretch and weakened while able to hold the show. BELLA MARIE was a bit eager early then well placed on the inside, chased while continuing to save ground on the far turn, moved out in upper stretch and tired. BUBBLEGUM BANDIT tracked the pace, made a bid nearing the quarter-pole, vied into upper stretch then gave way. CON ZAP lugged out a bit while three then four wide on the first turn, dropped back on the backstretch and failed to respond. A P DILLY was off two lengths behind the field, lagged at the rear and was no factor. (Rail at 10 Feet)
