TAPIA stalked the pace on the outside, gained the lead leaving the backstretch, shook clear near the quarter-pole, responded well when asked for more in upper stretch and drew off under steady urging. DIXIE DUST was urged along on the outside, advanced leaving the backstretch, chased four then three wide on the turn and secured the place while no match for the winner. IMPERIAL POMEROY stumbled at the start, recovered well and set the pace, dropped back midway through the turn, chased into the stretch and tired while able to get the show. JUSTASASSYCAT was hustled from the start, raced just behind the leader, chased on the turn and weakened. BADNESS was well placed just off the pace, dropped back near the seven-sixteenths pole, raced inside early on the turn, shifted three wide near the quarter-pole and came up empty. MOST DARLING raced just off the pace, went three wide on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and capitulated. LESLEY BE JUDGED stumbled at the start, settled off the pace, raced off the rail early on the turn, shifted four wide near the quarter-pole, came five wide into the stretch and failed to rally. LILLIE ABBIE raced well back in the field, went five wide early on the turn, dropped in near the five-sixteenths pole and failed to threaten. IDREAMOFAFRICA raced well back in the field, saved ground on the turn and was no factor. MISS BUSY stumbled at the start, was urged along while off the pace, went four wide on the turn and never reached contention. THEY CALL ME EDNA raced just off the early pace, dropped back near the seven-sixteenths pole, lugged out while two then three wide on the turn, drifted five wide into the stretch

and faltered.
