Footnotes

QUE DESEO settled off the pace, went three wide on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch, rallied on the outside and closed strongly to get up late. BENDANIE set the pace on the inside through solid fractions, was asked at the top of the stretch, extended the advantage into the final furlong, led into the final sixteenth but was caught. SOMMER'S CHOICE was unhurried towards the rear, came three wide into the stretch and finished well to just get the show. SWINGIN CAT settled in third position, was roused on the far turn, came between rivals near the furlong marker and finished fast but was too late. I NEED A BALEOUT saved ground on the first turn, settled off the pace, went three wide on the far turn and finished willingly. OVERNIGHT FLIGHT tracked the pace on the outside, chased on the far turn, pursued BENDANIE into the final furlong and lacked the needed kick. BLACK MARKET BRICK reared at the start, broke two to three lengths behind the rest of the field, raced inside on the first turn, moved up midway down the backstretch, saved ground on the far turn and came up empty. TATNALL STREET went three wide on the first turn, settled towards the rear, raced four wide on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch and failed to rally. (Rail at 10 Feet)
