Footnotes

TATNALL STREET tracked the pace while off the rail, engaged the leader on the far turn, dropped back a bit while drifting out under a left-handed whip in upper stretch, switched to a right-handed whip near the eighth-pole, battled determinedly in the final furlong and proved best. ROAD HAWK was well rated on the inside while setting an easy pace, came under pressure on the far turn, drifted out near the furlong marker and was caught while able to get the place. LANDON PAUL settled between rivals, was roused on the far turn, moved out in the stretch and finished well to get the show. CAPTURE THE FLAG was unhurried at the back while saving ground, waited while blocked passing the quarter-pole, shifted five wide once straightened for the drive and reached his best stride too late. U S C FIGHT SONG raced three wide on the first turn, settled near the back of the field while on the outside, was ridden along while four wide on the far turn and finished willingly but lacked the needed kick late. BOSTON FEROCIOUS raced three wide on the initial turn, was forwardly placed on the outside, chased three wide on the far turn and tired. PHANTOM ROAD was reserved on the inside then settled on the backstretch, came under urging on the far turn and had nothing left. CHANDAS raced four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while three wide on the far turn, shifted five wide near the quarter-pole and came up empty. (Rail at 10 Feet)
