RUSTY RED STAR contested the pace on the outside, battled with MSU SEATTLE SHADOW into the final furlong then edged clear under steady urging. WHISKEY MAN raced towards the front of the field, saved ground on the turn, moved out in deep stretch and finished willingly for the place. MSU SEATTLE SHADOW contested the pace on the inside, vied into the final furlong and weakened while able to hold the show. SAARMAN was urged along while off the pace, raced three then four wide on the turn, brushed with a rival near the furlong marker and improved position. TRICKY N' TARA settled off the pace, raced off the rail on the turn and failed to rally. OPPORTUNITY STAR bumped with a rival at the start, steadied early on the backstretch, raced five wide on the turn, brushed with a rival near the furlong marker and also failed to rally. UNBRIDLED CHIEF was away awkwardly, raced off the pace while ridden along, went three wide on the turn and came up empty. SANDFLAT PRO was in tight leaving the chute, raced in the middle of the field while urged along, dropped to the rail on the turn and failed to respond. RED TIMBER was in a bit tight early on the backstretch, raced well back in the field, came three wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. EL TAPIDERO moved out in traffic early on the backstretch, raced four wide on the turn and came up empty. SILVERDOLLAR DREAM saved ground towards the rear and was outrun. FIREMAN was ridden along near the inside, saved ground on the turn and was no factor. FINALLY EVEN broke outward and bumped with a rival, was through after a half-mile and retreated.
