RUNAWAY JEWEL set the pace through moderate fractions, battled gamely in the stretch and narrowly prevailed under strong urging. MIDNIGHT EXPLOSION chased the pace, vied three wide while between rivals on the turn, battled gamely in the stretch and just missed. REFINERY ROAD broke outward and brushed with a rival, chased the pace, vied between rivals on the turn, battled gamely in the stretch but missed. OSCAR WILDCAT was ridden along on the outside, advanced leaving the backstretch, vied four wide on the turn and weakened. HONOR AMERICA brushed with a rival at the start, was urged along while just off the pace, raced three to four wide early on the turn, moved to five wide near the quarter-pole and came up empty. SUNNY QUEST was urged along on the inside, saved ground on the turn and faded. HAMMER'S VIEW lacked early speed, saved ground on the turn and failed to threaten. LUKEN BOSS bobbled after the start, was urged along while off the pace, raced four to five wide early on the turn, moved to six wide near the five-sixteenths pole and faltered.
