Footnotes

LASTING BUBBLES contested the pace on the outside, moved clear with five furlongs to run, extended the advantage on the turn and drew off under strong urging. PRINCESS GAGA raced in the front half of the field, chased two to three wide on the turn and narrowly earned the place. LOUWALA CLOUGH settled off the pace, chased three to four wide on the turn and just missed the place. BOGGY BLUE raced in the middle of the field while off the rail, dropped to the inside near the quarter-pole and failed to threaten. SHE'S BONAFIDE broke in at the start, contested the early pace then chased the winner, raced inside on the turn and came up empty. RIVER RAPIDS dropped well off the pace and failed to threaten. NEW DAWN FAWN broke about three lengths behind the field and was no factor. MISS SERENA dropped well back and was always outrun. COMMON GOLD broke a bit slow then was slow into stride and showed little.
