Footnotes

WENCESLAO (MEX) was well placed just off the pace, shifted three wide into the stretch, made a bid outside the furlong marker, inched clear into the final sixteenth and held under strong urging. EVANSVILLE RUNAWAY saved ground on the first turn, lingered well back in the field, advanced four to five wide on the far turn, made a bid nearing the furlong marker, drifted about while doing so and finished willingly for the place. SULLEYMAN TIME leaned in at the start, was last away, raced three wide on the first turn, lingered well back in the field, shifted six wide near the quarter-pole, found his best stride in the final furlong and finished with good energy. ROSSINI'S EMINENCE contested the pace on the inside, vied into the final furlong and weakened. SLEWSH BOX went four wide on the first turn, contested the pace on the outside, vied into the final furlong and tired. ARETHEREANYCOOKIES was rank near the three-quarter pole, went three wide on the first turn, was reserved off the pace, raced two to three wide on the far turn, moved out once straightened for the drive and lacked the needed kick. RUNAWAY CRYPTO went three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, raced three to four wide on the far turn, was in tight near the quarter-pole and also lacked the needed kick. FOUR FLAGS was well placed on the inside, saved ground through the far turn and came up empty. (Rail at 20 Feet)
