WISH AGAIN was reserved well off the pace on the outside, raced three then four wide on the far turn, rallied at the top of the stretch, closed fast to get the lead passing the furlong marker, ducked in shortly thereafter, was straightened out under left hand urging and narrowly prevailed under strong handling. JENZ BENZ settled towards the rear of the field, moved out in upper stretch and closed fast to just miss. RIVER AT TWILIGHT settled on the outside, was urged along on the far turn, came three wide into the stretch and lacked the needed kick while up for the show. SENORA TORMENTA raced three wide on the first turn, was well placed in the second flight, chased three wide on the far turn, gained the lead in upper stretch, lost the lead passing the furlong marker, was carried in shortly thereafter and weakened then was caught for the show. GATHERING SKY was reserved on the inside, waited behind rivals on the far turn, was blocked in upper stretch and failed to rally when clear. I LOVE TO SAY YES settled near the middle of the field, saved ground on both turns, was blocked from the eighth-pole to the sixteenth-pole and lost all chance. ZARAGOZA contested the pace on the outside, was taken up inside the furlong marker and gave way. BELLE'S EXPERIENCE tracked the pace on the inside, engaged the leader near the seven-sixteenths pole, vied inside on the far turn, battled into the final furlong and tired. FLYING PRESS broke out a bit at the start, raced three to four wide on the first turn, lagged at the rear of the field, came four wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. SILENT PATH was in tight leaving the chute, shifted three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, saved ground on the far turn and failed to respond. BERRY DELIGHTFUL reared badly at the start and unseated the rider. Following the race, the

stewards' conducted an inquiry into the start and the stretch run. After the review, there was no change made to the order of finish. (Rail at 0 Feet)
