U GO ROY went four wide on the first turn, was forwardly placed on the outside, made a bid while four wide on the far turn, battled with AVEC GLASS into the final furlong and edged clear under strong urging. AVEC GLASS was asked from the start, set the pace while off the rail, battled into the final furlong and was second best. ANARCHY was well placed on the inside, chased on the far turn and tired while just able to get the show. APRIL EXPECTATIONS settled well off the pace, went four wide on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch and improved position. DOUBLEUPTOCATCHUP saved ground on the first turn, lagged well back in the field, was urged along while off the rail on the far turn, moved out near the three-sixteenths pole and failed to threaten. I AM TARZAN raced just off the pace, dropped back while two to three wide on the far turn, shifted four wide into the stretch and came up empty. GO FOR DOUGH raced three wide on the first turn and was no factor. LANGALEER settled on the inside, saved ground on the turns and also failed to threaten. FIFTGRADEFIELDTRIP went three wide on the first turn, tracked the pace, chased three wide on the far turn and tired. I'M ONE KOOL DUDE raced four wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, went three to four wide on the far turn and failed to respond.
