DIXIELAND PARADE raced inside early on the first turn then came off the rail, settled off the pace, bided her time while off the rail on the far turn, was asked near the quarter-pole, shifted out in upper stretch, closed strongly to get the lead near the sixteenth-pole and prevailed under urging. MORE THAN THAT went two to three wide on the first turn, stalked the pace on the outside, went three then two wide on the far turn, made a bid near the five-sixteenths pole, inched clear in upper stretch, lost the lead near the sixteenth-pole and was outfinished while clear for the place. K D QUEEN raced off the rail early on the first turn then dropped to the inside, settled along the rail, was urged along on the far turn, moved out in upper stretch finished willingly for the show. ZALISA went three then two wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, moved closer with a half-mile to run, raced inside early on the far turn then came off the rail, shifted four wide near the quarter-pole, came under a drive and weakened. DULCE DE BATATA went three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, moved up near the half-mile pole, was urged along while three to four wide on the far turn and lacked the needed kick. OPEN SUMMARY went four wide early on the first turn then dropped in, set the pace, vied inside on the far turn, dropped back under a drive in upper stretch and gave way. ROYAL CHA CHA lagged at the rear of the field, raced off the rail on the turns and showed little. PEPPERMINT BLING went three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while four to five wide on the far turn and failed to respond. COUSHATA LADY raced inside early on the first turn then came off the rail, prompted the pace outside the leader, came up empty on the far turn and stopped.
