Footnotes

SOUTH BRANCH STORM was off slow, raced at the back of the field, shifted four wide near the quarter-pole, rallied five wide into the stretch, closed fast on the outside, drifted in a bit while taking the lead near the furlong marker and drew clear under strong right hand urging. CALL TRANSFER was ridden along while off the pace, came three wide into the stretch, moved out and bumped with MARK HIS WORD inside the three-sixteenths pole, steadied inside the furlong marker and secured the place. RIDEITLIKEUSTOLEIT bobbed at the start, pressed the pace on the outside, was taken up while lugging in a bit in upper stretch and weakened while clear for the show. MARK HIS WORD came in at the start, was ridden along on the outside, raced three to four wide on the turn, was bumped and in tight in upper stretch then came up empty. FRENCH DIPLOMAT set the pace under pressure, lost the lead passing the furlong marker and tired. MY ANGEL came in a bit just after the start, chased the pace on the inside, raced near the rail on the turn and gave way. ZINO PLATINUM broke a bit slow then was forced in, climbed while behind rivals on the backstretch, saved ground on the turn and failed to threaten. Following the race, the rider of CALL TRANSFER claimed foul against the rider of SOUTH BRANCH STORM for interference in the stretch. After the stewards' review, there was no change made to the order of finish.
