BAR BA CAT went to the early lead, set the pace while off the rail, was asked when challenged by GRETA'S AFFAIR on the far turn, shifted out while moving clear at the top of the stretch and extended the advantage under steady urging. SUPER SHAN raced three wide into the first turn then dropped to the inside, was well placed just behind the leader, dropped back while ridden along on the far turn, saved ground into the stretch, battled with WAMPAS KITTY for the place and narrowly earned that position while no match for the winner. WAMPAS KITTY raced three wide on the first turn, settled just off the pace on the outside, dropped back while ridden along on the far turn, battled with SUPER SHAN for the place and just missed that position. GRETA'S AFFAIR raced three wide on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, made a bid leaving the backstretch, vied three wide on the far turn, dropped behind the winner at the top of the stretch, drifted out near the furlong marker and weakened. SAPPHIREDIAMONDS settled off the pace, went three wide on the far turn and failed to threaten. LA CANNE CAN raced three wide on the first turn, lingered towards the rear, moved in near the half-mile pole, saved ground on the final turn and was no factor. LONE STAR TWISTER raced well back in the field, saved ground on the turns and failed to respond.
