RIVERSIDES BEST chased the pace, made a bid passing the three-eighths pole, shook clear inside the furlong marker and drew away under strong urging. ABENDLIED was urged along on the outside, made a bid near the three-eighths pole, vied four wide on the turn, battled into the final furlong and proved no match while clear for the place. TOMATOE MAGIC was ridden along at the back, moved out on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and got up for the show. JONES WAY was urged along while just off the pace, made a bid between rivals passing the three-eighths pole, vied three wide on the turn, battled into the final furlong and tired. TEXAS CITY THOR was ridden along while off the pace, raced off the rail on the turn and failed to threaten. AFLEET CAPTUN broke in at the start, moved up to take the lead, set the pace on the inside, dropped out near the quarter-pole and faded. CHURNER bolted on the backstretch and was eased then walked off.
