Footnotes

ONE SLEET DEAL dropped to the rail midway through the first turn, was well rated while setting the pace, responded well in the stretch and drew off under steady urging. STATICE raced off the rail on the first turn, was reserved at the back of the field, passed rivals while three wide on the far turn and secured the place while no match for the winner. EXPLOSIVE OKIE settled while off the rail, was urged along on the far turn, dropped to the rail near the quarter-pole and came up empty while best of the rest. CLUB TEJANO raced three then two wide on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, chased while off the rail on the far turn and weakened. GENERAL PARKS came out at the start, settled on the inside, was in tight midway through the far turn, shifted three wide near the quarter-pole, came four wide into the stretch and had nothing left. TATNALL STREET broke awkwardly and was off slow, raced three to four wide on the turns and faded.
