CHANDAS raced three wide on the first turn, contested the pace on the outside, edged clear while off the rail on the far turn and drew away under strong hand urging. SWANKY FRANKY raced off the rail on the first turn, shifted in midway down the backstretch then moved up on the inside, came off the rail near the quarter-pole and earned the place while no match for the winner. SHANNON'S PHANTOM raced three then two wide on the first turn, was well placed just off the pace, chased three wide on the far turn and came up empty while best of the rest. GILDED WOODMAN was hustled from the start, raced off the rail on the first turn then dropped in near the three-quarter pole, contested the pace on the inside, vied inside on the far turn and tired. AUSTINS HOME broke a bit slow, raced three wide on the first turn, lingered well back in the field, went two to three wide on the far turn and failed to threaten. FIREMAN settled on the inside, saved ground on both turns and failed to respond. AIR TRAFFIC raced four wide on the first turn, floated six wide near the three-quarter pole, was forwardly placed on the outside, bore out badly on the far turn and faltered. SWORD CAT raced four wide on the first turn, was urged along on the backstretch and retreated.
