Footnotes

BIG SCRAPE broke a bit in the air and was last away, was a bit rank while three then four wide on the first turn, settled outside on the backstretch, engaged the leaders while four wide on the far turn, was put to a right-handed whip at the top of the stretch, battled with NO REGRET into the final furlong and inched clear under continued right hand urging. NO REGRET bumped with a rival at the start, contested the pace on the outside, vied between rivals then inside of horses on the far turn, battled with BIG SCRAPE into the final furlong and was outfinished while well clear for the place. RAYMOND'S BREW raced four then three wide on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, made a bid with three furlongs to run, vied three wide on the far turn and weakened while just able to save the show. SHOTGUN RYDER raced near the inside on the first turn, settled at the back of the field, was urged along while three then four wide on the far turn and failed to rally. PLEASANTLY GOLD bumped with a rival at the start, went three then two wide on the first turn, was rated just off the pace, bided his time while two then three wide on the far turn, was asked in the vicinity of the quarter-pole and faltered. PLAYGROUND was asked from the start, contested the pace on the inside, dropped out midway through the turn and faded.
