STAKES Alysheba Breeders' Cup S. Listed - Thoroughbred

(PLUS UP TO \$9,000 Open ATB) FOR THREE YEAR OLDS. No nomination fee. \$750 to pass the entry box and an additional \$750 to start with \$50,000 guaranteed and an additional \$50,000 guaranteed from the Breeders' Cup Fund for Cup nominees only. The host association guaranteed monies to be divided 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Breeders' Cup Fund monies also correspondingly divided, provided a Breeders' Cup nominee has finished in an awarded position. Any Breeders' Cup monies not awarded will revert back to the Fund. Weight: 123 lbs. Non-winners of \$30,000 twice in 2005 allowed 3 lbs.; \$30,000 in 2005, 5 lbs.; \$18,000 in 2004-2005, 7 lbs. Maiden and claiming races not considered in allowances. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. High weights preferred. Breeders' Cup Nominees only of equal weight assignment will be given first preference. The field will be limited to fourteen starters. Horses not drawing a starting position in the gate will receive a refund of the entry fee. Trophy to the winning owner given by Breeders' Cup Ltd. Nominations closed Wednesday, June 22, 2005 with 25 nominations.

SANTANA STRINGS dueled between rivals then outside of WAR BRIDLE, battled with that rival into the final furlong then edged clear under left hand urging. WAR BRIDLE drifted in slightly after the start, dueled on the inside, vied into the final furlong and weakened while clear for the place. LOGAN'S DRAW was well placed just behind the leaders, saved ground on the turn and came up empty while able to best the rest. STORMY BUT CRAFTY broke outward at the start, pressed the pace while three wide and tired. CITY CODE broke a step slow then was ridden along, steadied near the half-mile marker, raced between rivals on the turn and faltered.
