CINEMATIC ROSE settled off the pace, raced three wide on the turn, rallied four wide into the stretch, shifted out inside the three-sixteenths pole, closed fast to get the lead then drew clear under strong handling. ALY'S TRIPLE LUCK was a bit reluctant to load, raced well back in the field, went two then three wide on the turn and finished willingly for the place. LUKEY'S LA TEE DA brushed with a rival at the start then swerved out, advanced on the outside to take the lead, lugged out while four wide on the turn, lost the lead in upper stretch and weakened while able to hold the show. LIL' JULIE was away alertly and showed good speed, chased while off the rail on the turn and tired. SERENA VENUS was ridden along while off the pace, raced five wide on the turn and came up empty. MARKED FOR A FLING broke inward at the start, was urged along on the inside, saved ground on the turn and capitulated. ORANGE COLORED SKY was very reluctant to load, settled off the pace, raced off the rail on the turn and failed to respond. CORDIAL CONNECTION brushed with a rival at the start then was beaten for speed, raced three to four wide on the turn and was no factor.
