J J'S INDY settled just off the pace, was urged along while two to three wide on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch, made a bid shortly thereafter, battled with ONE CALL into the final furlong, disposed of that rival near the sixteenth-pole and held under steady urging. LITTLE WAGON saved ground on the first turn, settled at the back, was urged along while three then four wide on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch, rallied on the outside and closed well but missed. ONE CALL tracked the pace on the outside, engaged the leader on the far turn, came three wide into the stretch, battled into the final furlong and was outfinished while able to get the show. DAKOTA GYPSY settled on the inside, steadied early on the far turn, drafted behind rivals passing the quarter-pole, came three wide into the stretch, was roused while behind horses and lacked the needed kick. KICK ON set the pace on the inside, drifted off the rail entering the stretch, vied into the final furlong and gave way. ROAD HAWK settled just off the pace on the inside, was urged along on the far turn, held a good striking position into the final furlong but weakened. TIZ BIZ bobbed at the start, raced three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while two then three wide on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch and failed to rally. (Rail at 20 Feet)
