Footnotes

GRUMPY'S GAL set a pressured pace, was challenged by CLAIM MY LOVE entering the turn, dueled with that rival into the final yards, and edged away under strong right hand urging. CLAIM MY LOVE pressed the pace on the inside, engaged GRUMPY'S GAL near the three-eighths pole, dueled with that rival into deep stretch, but gave way. DIAMOND OF MINE raced well off the pace, rallied on the turn, swung five wide entering the stretch, and finished willingly for the show while no threat to the top two. MUNDO OF SEA broke outward and bumped with a rival, settled towards the back of the field, and improved position. CROOK'S COOL raced in tight quarters near the half mile pole, saved ground into the stretch, and weakened. ALLURING TRAPP was fractious in the post parade, raced well back in the field, entered the turn four wide, dropped to the rail midway through the turn, and finished evenly in the stretch. HORKA raced near mid field, steadied near the three-eighths pole when MAGIC MORA bore out, went four wide on the turn, entered the stretch seven wide, and failed to menace. CHRISTAVILLA was forwardly placed from the start, raced four wide on the turn, and faded in the stretch. ALLEGEDLY

AN ANGEL raced well back in the field, went five wide on the turn, and showed little. WHISPERONTHEWIND tracked the pace from the start, but was through early and retreated. FANCYMEFITZ swerved out after the start, was carried extremely wide on the turn, and was no factor thereafter. MORNINGSTAR AGENDA was fractious in the gate, broke inward and bumped a rival, and was always outrun. MAGIC MORA was off a touch slow, rushed up to be in mid pack, bore out badly on the turn, and was eased but walked off.
