UNCLE ROSE brushed with a rival at the start, was well placed near the inside, commenced a rally midway through the far turn, closed well to get the lead inside the furlong marker then edged clear under strong handling. RACIN GRAYSON broke inward and bumped with a rival, contested the pace, moved clear midway down the backstretch, remained clear into upper stretch, lost the lead inside the furlong marker and was outfinished while well clear for the place. WACO HUG broke a bit slow, lagged near the back of the field, raced three then four wide on the far turn and was best of the rest. FR. DENIS raced four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while three to four wide on the far turn and came up empty. HANDSOME BILL raced three wide on the first turn and failed to threaten. BRASS BAND raced three wide on the first turn, settled between rivals, went three to four wide on the far turn and faded. CONTROL FREAK brushed with a rival at the start, settled off the pace and retreated. OH OLEG bumped with a rival at the start, contested the pace, dropped back midway down the backstretch, came up empty on the far turn and stopped.
