Footnotes

WEEKEND THUNDER raced three wide on the first turn, tracked the pace, drew even midway down the backstretch, edged clear in upper stretch and proved best under strong left hand urging. MUSTANG BOB bobbled at the start, moved in entering the first turn, settled just off the pace, chased while off the rail on the far turn and secured the place while unable to match the winner. B G ROYAL WEST was hustled from the start, set the clear pace, was challenged midway down the backstretch, vied inside on the far turn and gave way. DOUBLEUPTOCATCHUP raced four wide on the first turn, settled just off the pace on the outside, chased three wide on the far turn and came up empty. TAPPYHOUR unseated the rider during the post parade and ran loose for at least a quarter of a mile, was off slow, raced three to four wide on the turns and was no factor. ABBOTS ABBIE broke in the air and was off slow, raced towards the rear of the field and failed to respond. SLEWS SUENADOR moved in entering the first turn, was well placed on the inside, dropped back while in tight near the three-eighths pole and faded. (Rail at 10 Feet)
