Footnotes

MAGGIES SNOWMAN was ridden along on the outside, raced four then three wide on the turn, rallied in the stretch and closed well to win going away. COMO SE LLAMA showed good speed, sprinted well clear of the field, held a commanding advantage while off the rail on the turn, was put to a left-handed whip in upper stretch, switched to a right-handed whip passing the furlong marker, led into the final sixteenth but was overtaken while clear for the place. UP FOR A RODEO was ridden along in second place, raced off the rail early on the turn, dropped to the inside near the quarter-pole and narrowly earned the show while no match for the top two. GOLD ROAD MINE was ridden along in the front half of the field, raced three then two wide on the turn and failed to rally then just missed the show. GENTRY'S GOLD raced well back in the field went two then three wide on the turn and failed to threaten. LUVNAROLLERCOASTR broke in the air but relatively with the field, moved in near the half-mile pole, saved ground on the turn and failed to respond. TERE'S SHINE broke a bit slow then ducked in sharply, raced at the rear of the field, went three then four wide on the turn and was no factor. TOUGH FORUM was ridden along while well off the pace, saved ground on the turn and never reached contention. ROYAL GOLD was ridden along while off the pace, raced off the rail on the turn and retreated.
